Etiquette for Working Livery/D.I.Y. Livery Clients

Welcome! Whilst you are using our facilities it is expected that you will observe the following:

YOU

Safety is most important. Stay alert at all times.

Always wear suitable clothing for the activity – boots/hats/body protectors/gloves

Do not walk behind horses in the yard or make sudden movements or noises

Keep personal and yard equipment stored tidily

Do not feed other horses without their owner's consent

Do not use other people's horse feed and equipment

YOUR PONY

He/she is the reason you are here – treat him/her with respect

You may use an un-named stable if you wish, but clean it carefully afterwards

Brush your pony thoroughly underneath the saddle and girth areas to prevent sores

Clean your pony's tack from time to time

Whatever activity you are doing: you **MUST** warm up and cool down your pony properly

Do not feed haylage on the floor in the yard

Feed titbits in a bucket or on the floor – hand feeding encourages horses to bite

THE ARENA

Observe the rules of the Arena which are:-

Pass other riders left hand to left hand

Do not halt or walk on the outside track if there are other riders present

Halt if a rider falls off

All droppings **MUST** be removed immediately. These should be barrowed to the Muck heap – **NOT** over the fence

Lunging may only take place when no-one is riding. Instruction only to be given by our Instructors unless previously arranged

Please leave the Arena as you find it

DO NOT joyride the ponies – treat them with the love they deserve and make life fun – vary what you do!

GENERAL

Bring any safety issues, accidents or dangerous occurrences to our attention immediately

If you are not sure about anything – ask, most people will be pleased to give you advice

Children under 14 must be supervised at all times

Gates and stable doors to be kept closed at all times

The blue tub by the main tap is for horses drinking water and **MUST** be kept clean

Both water and electricity are metered. Use them carefully and turn off to keep costs down

Empty wheelbarrows and heap the muck forward on the trailer

Leave the toilet clean and tidy

Either use the bins provided or take your rubbish home
