


Fire Policy. October 2018

A plan of the site and location of fire-fighting equipment is shown below. The general public are advised <u>NOT</u> to attempt to fight the fire, leave this to trained members of staff.



Any evacuation of horses must be made under the control of members of staff.

On detecting a fire or hearing the fire alarm follow the instructions in the evacuation procedure (Appendix 1). Evacuation procedure notices are on display on the site.

# Fire Evacuation Procedure (staff)

- In the event of a fire:
- Raise the SHOUT FIRE or RING THE FIRE BELL
- Phone the Fire Brigade.
- On hearing the alarm: The state of the princed to entire animals.
