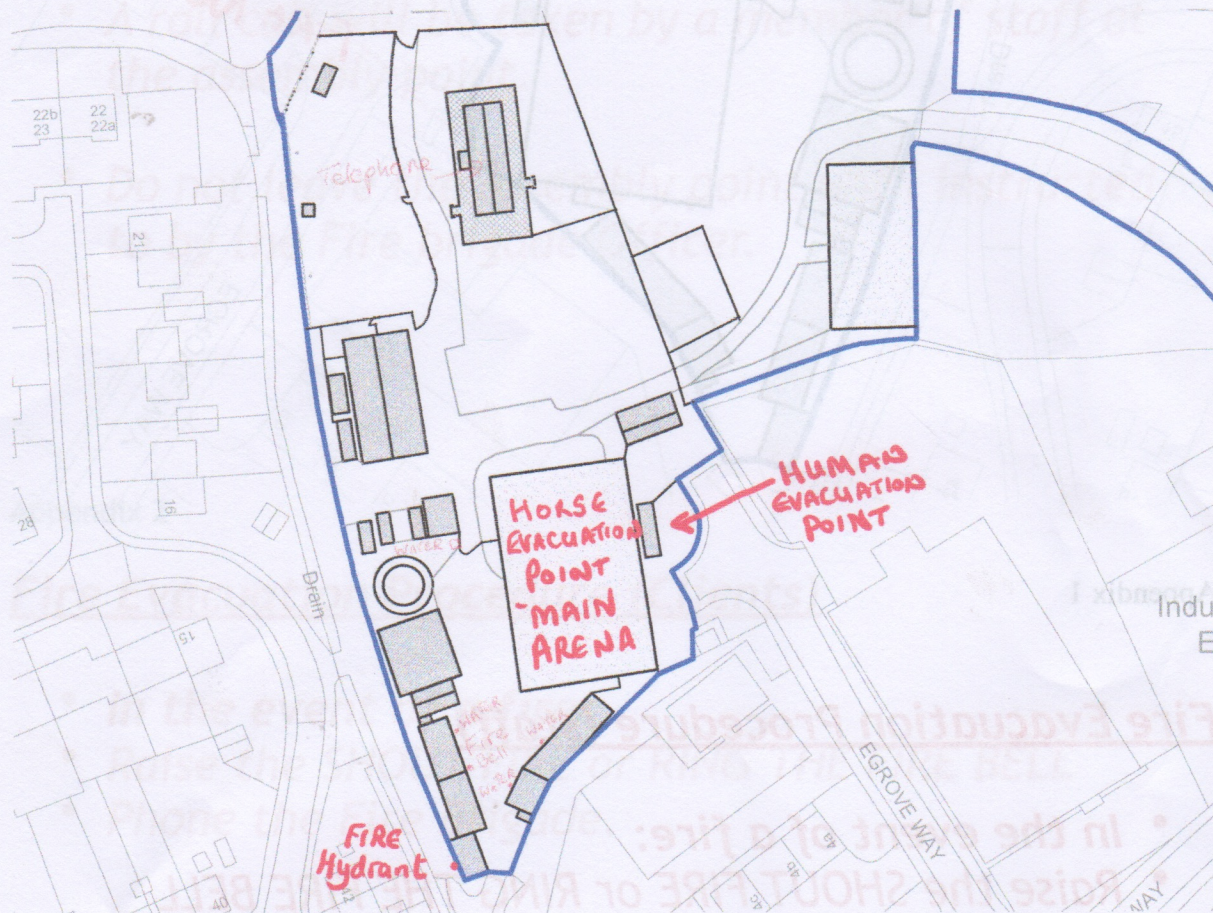


# RED PARK EQUESTRIAN CENTRE

Fire Policy.  
October 2018

A plan of the site and location of fire-fighting equipment is shown below. The general public are advised NOT to attempt to fight the fire, leave this to trained members of staff.



Any evacuation of horses must be made under the control of members of staff.

On detecting a fire or hearing the fire alarm follow the instructions in the evacuation procedure (Appendix 1). Evacuation procedure notices are on display on the site.





## Appendix 1

### Fire Evacuation Procedure (staff)

- *In the event of a fire:*
- *Raise the SHOUT FIRE or RING THE FIRE BELL*
- *Phone the Fire Brigade.*
- *On hearing the alarm:*
- *All horses that can be safely moved should be taken to BIG ARENA*
- *Shut as many gates and doors as possible.*



- Go straight to the fire assembly point which is located **BY THE PORTACABIN**
- DO NOT stop to collect personal belongings.
- DO NOT risk your life trying to fight any fire, leave this to the trained staff.
- DO NOT re-enter the building that is on fire.
  
- A roll call will be taken by a member of staff at the assembly point.
  
- Do not leave the assembly point until instructed to by the Fire brigade Officer.

## Appendix 2

### Fire Evacuation Procedure (Clients)

- In the event of a fire:
  - Raise the SHOUT FIRE or RING THE FIRE BELL
  - Phone the Fire Brigade.
  
- On hearing the alarm:
  - Go straight to the fire assembly point which is located **BY THE PORTACABIN**
  - DO NOT stop to collect personal belongings.
  - DO NOT risk your life trying to fight any fire, leave this to the trained staff.
  - DO NOT re-enter the building that is on fire.



- A roll call will be taken by a member of staff at the assembly point.
- Do not leave the assembly point until instructed to by the Fire brigade Officer.
