Training

- We will make sure suitable arrangements are in place for lone workers

Consultation

• We will consult staff routinely on health and safety matters as they arise and formerly when we review health and safety

Evacuation

- We will make sure that escape routes are kept clear and free from obstructions
- Evacuation plans will be made available and tested from time to time and updated if necessary
